(Tickets must be purchased to gain access to the showgrounds)

RULES:

- All participants must be eligible as defined in the rules of IAAF, ASA, AFS
- Minimum age on the day of the race:
42 km: 20 years
21 km: 16 years
10 km: 16 years
5 km Funrun: 9 years
(younger children only if an adult accompanies them)
- Unlicensed athletes on the 42.2 km, 21.1 km and the 10 km must purchase a temporary license number. The number to be worn on the front. Take note when purchasing a temporary license the runner are eligible for insurance for the duration of the race only. This means it is vital to complete the tear-off slip on the number and this must be handed back at the entry table. The 5 km do not need a temporary license number.
- All participants must produce their official race entry bag with label at the end of their race to qualify for a medal or certificate. Failure to do so will result in immediate disqualification.
- All participants take part in the race at their own risk.
- Race officials must be obeyed at all times. Failure to do so can lead to immediate disqualification.
- Participants' ID's must be available on request.
- Assistance can be given at the different water points without interfering with the sponsors and volunteers of the water point. No other assistance will be permitted on the route from cyclists or private vehicles or spectators.
- No advertisements may be displayed on running clothing. IAAF Rule
- The decision of the organization will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Foreign athletes competing for the prize money must produce a clearance certificate from their national bodies to compete in SA, handed in to the organisers before the event starts.
- Safety rule - No earphones, excluding hearing aid, IAAF Rule 144.2b, Animals ASA Rule 21.4.1 or Racers ASA Rule 21.4.3 allowed.
