RULES:

- Age restrictions apply: Minimum age for 93 km 18 years; 50 km 16 years; 21 km 10 years; 15 km 6 years
- 2. All marshals, traffic authorities and traffic rules must be obeyed. Failing to do so may lead to disqualification.
- Check point on route. Keep left at all times. In case of emergencies, report to the next water point.
- Evacuation point will be at the start and finish point at the Reitz Showgrounds.
- Due to the nature of the course no wheelchairs, prams, roller blades, animals, electric cycles or mechanically operated devices are allowed, excluding hearing aids.
- No seconding or cars will be allowed on the course as there are sufficient refreshment tables. Seconding can only be permitted in the demarcated area of a water point allocated to individuals.
- Cut-off time is 12:00
- 8. Proof of age must be provided on the day of the race if requested.

- The organisers reserve the right to return any entry from cyclists not acting in the spirit of the race.
- The decision of the organisers will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Participants must take responsibility for their own actions when disposing of litter. Acting irresponsibly could lead to disqualification.
